

MARY FLY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS FOR DRIVER EDUCATION APPLICATION PACKET

General Information for Scholarship Applicants

WHY IS DRIVER EDUCATION NEEDED?

Teenagers have more traffic crashes, resulting in higher insurance, injuries and death. Research has shown the driving problems of teenagers to be the result of driving inexperience, lack of adequate driving skills, driving during high risk hours, risk taking, and poor driving judgment and decision-making. In the mountains areas, there are other contributing factors, including road conditions and weather.

Driver Education can help reduce traffic crashes by giving students a better understanding of how drivers interact with the driving environment, knowledge about the driving process, improved driving skills, and better risk perception and decision-making. While parents and guardians have an important role to play in teaching their children to drive, they can be assisted and supported through Driver Education.

THE MARY FLY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS:

The “Mary Fly Memorial Scholarships for Driver Education” honor a valued and dedicated member of the DRIVE SMART Evergreen/Conifer Board of Directors who died tragically in April, 1996. **The scholarships are designed to offer driver education classes to students who, due to financial or other circumstances, would not otherwise have the opportunity to take them.** Up to 30 scholarships are available in this grant cycle from Master Drive and Drive Safe, and are made possible by the generosity of the driving schools, Drive Smart Evergreen-Conifer, and Evergreen Fire and Rescue.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. The student must reside in the matriculation areas of Evergreen, Conifer, Platte Canyon, and Clear Creek High Schools.
2. The student must presently be 14 years 6 months to apply. Older students of high school age who have not taken driver education will also be considered.
3. Parents or guardians of the student must commit to transporting the student to the driver education classes and to supplying a car for off-road instruction if necessary.
4. Parents or guardians must certify in the application that their child could not take driver education classes without our financial aid.
5. The student and parents or guardians must agree to accept scholarship awarded regardless of driving school assigned.
6. Driver education classes must be started within 6 months of receiving notification of a scholarship and completed within 6 months of enrollment.
7. The student and parent must each agree to volunteer for a minimum of 10 hours for Drive Smart Evergreen-Conifer. **These hours must be logged** with Grace Gabrielli Drive Smart’s Volunteer Coordinator and will be monitored closely.

GENERAL INFORMATION**

SCHOLARSHIPS OFFERED:

Master Drive: (classroom and on-street driving in southeast or west Denver; skills weekend at 15659 E. Hinsdale, Englewood, CO or at Jefferson Stadium in Lakewood, CO) Three days of classroom instruction; twelve hours of on-street driving instruction and observation; and “Skills Weekend” – two full days of in-car training in basic driving maneuvers (backing, control dynamics, smoothness, accident avoidance, braking and handling, skid pad and driving dynamics), conducted at low speeds at a controlled facility. The student uses their own vehicle for the skills weekend only.

Drive Safe: 30 hours of classroom instruction at any of our class locations including Evergreen, Morrison, Wheat Ridge, Westminster, or Englewood. The classroom program contains 10 three hour sessions. Classes can be taken in any order as long as Session 10 is saved for last. Six hours of private Behind-the-Wheel training, plus the written permit test. Driving lessons are customized to the skill of each student but generally consist of a residential, downtown, and highway drive. Defensive Skills Day: a full day which teaches new drivers how to deal with hazards and other unanticipated situations. Skills covered include taking evasive action, sudden braking and maintaining car control at all times.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Complete the entire application, and obtain the two recommendations.

Scholarships will be based on financial need and quality of application.

The selection committee will be composed of current DRIVE SMART Evergreen/Conifer board members, staff and involved community members.

An individual interview of the applicant and parent(s)/guardian(s) will be part of the selection process.
